FREIGHT & LUGGAGE

To minimise contact please take your luggage directly to the ferry at boarding time. One Piece of Luggage under 20 kg or 300mm sq, Excess charges otherwise apply Please take your luggage with your when you depart the ferry.

Please note: Mask wearing on public transport is now mandatory. You are required to arrive at the ferry wearing your mask which must be worn while on board. Wherever possible passengers should try to leave a gap and limit movement on board. It is important to note that COVID SAFE plans will vary between our facilities according to operational configurations.
